Since 1962, Hull Child and Family Services has been serving our community's most severely disturbed and tragically abused young people. This organization strives to reach at-risk children, youth, young adults and families sooner, through prevention and early intervention programs. The goal is to help children and families be healthy and stay healthy.

The children and families whom Hull deals with, struggle with emotional and psychological disorders, behavioural problems, learning disabilities, mental illness, developmental delay, family breakdown, as well as neglect and abuse (physical, emotional and sexual). Some of the children who come to Hull feel helpless and believe their futures are hopeless; many are even suicidal. Often they are society's disposable kids. Fortunately, Hull is there to help. Now, in 2009, Hull operates two dozen programs, which touch the lives of over 3,000 people each day.

Hull provides a continuum of services, including specialized therapy, counselling and education. Our programs are delivered in a wide variety of settings throughout Calgary (in family homes, community schools, various neighbourhoods and our residential treatment campus). As we continue to serve those in greatest need, Hull is increasing its efforts to make the community better for all children and families. Our kids learn to appreciate that they are worthwhile, loved, safe and that there is hope for their future.

Hull Child and Family Services' mission is to help young people and their families achieve success in their lives.
